FLAGS FLOWN AT HALF STAFF IN HONOR OF
NEW MEXICO STATE POLICE OFFICER CHRISTOPHER MIRABAL

WHEREAS, NMSP Officer Christopher Mirabal age 35, tragically lost his life in the line of duty on Wednesday, June 13, 2007 in Alamogordo, New Mexico;

WHEREAS, NMSP Officer Christopher Mirabal was a 1998 graduate of the 60th NMSP Recruit School and was a member of the NMSP Motorcycle Unit since July 2004;

WHEREAS, NMSP Officer Christopher Mirabal is survived by his wife, Nichole Mirabal, children, Kennedie and Nathan Mirabal, his parents, Robert and Corina Mirabal and his in-laws Joel and Tony Duran, all from Alamogordo; and

WHEREAS, NMSP Officer Christopher Mirabals' patriotism, bravery and dedication to the State of New Mexico will always be remembered.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Governor Bill Richardson, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby order that all flags be flown at half-staff from Monday, June 18, 2007, until sundown on Tuesday, June 19, 2007, in honor and mourning of NMSP Officer Christopher Mirabal.
