

Governor Bill Richardson Answers Town Meeting Concerns- Announces Motor Vehicle Division Will Expand Clayton Office Hours to Full-Time

SANTA FE- Governor Bill Richardson announced today that effective July 1, the hours of operation for the Clayton office of the New Mexico Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) will expand to full-time. The office will now be open from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. The action follows a town meeting in Clayton last Thursday where dozens of residents expressed their concerns to Governor Richardson.

“I heard the people of Clayton loud and clear,” said Governor Richardson. “Residents shouldn’t have to travel long distances or take extraordinary measures to do business with MVD. Now they won’t have to.”

Previously, the office in Clayton was open from 8 a.m. until 1 p.m. The office will have one, full-time employee. The additional hours will be paid for through savings with open positions.
