SANTA FE- Governor Bill Richardson will officially kickoff a public display of an original copy of the Declaration of Independence at the State Capitol Wednesday morning. The document is one of only 25 remaining original copies, printed on the evening of July 4, 1776, and the only one traveling the nation. It will be on display in the Capitol Rotunda from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday, October 15 and 16.
