Governor Bill Richardson announces plans for new Mora library

Governor gets \$200,000 for library; \$250,000 for Chacon Water System

Mora - Governor Richardson today announced that Mora County will receive \$225,000 in state funding for a new library. The Governor pledged \$200,000 of his capital money to help build the new library.

“The fight for a new, state-of-the-art library is closer to breaking ground,” Governor Bill Richardson said during a news conference today. “I made a commitment to Mora, and I’m keeping it by contributing \$200,000 of my share of the capital package to this library. I know Governor Cargo has worked hard for every scrap of money he can find to replace the library he helped create back in 1991.”

The Legislature kicked in another \$25,000 for the library, bringing the total state contribution to \$225,000. The money is part of a \$1.6 million package of capital projects that will fund important projects to improve schools, water systems, roads and infrastructure, and other community needs.

“The critically needed projects we’re funding directly address the statewide priorities the Legislature and I agreed upon,” said Governor Richardson. “These projects will help drive economic development, create jobs, and improve the quality of life for all New Mexicans.”
