Lt. Governor to Sign Bills Aimed at Cracking Down on Production of Methamphetamine, and Strengthening Penalties for Producing Meth with Children Present

SANTA FE- Lt. Governor Diane Denish will hold a news conference Thursday at 11:30 a.m., in the Cabinet Room of the State Capitol.

At the news conference, the Lt. Governor will sign bills related to the crime of producing methamphetamine, commonly referred to as "meth". The Lt. Governor will sign House Bills 111 & 112, and Senate Bills 160 & 161, which will restrict access to the chemicals required to produce meth, and toughen penalties for offenders who produce meth with children present.

Lt. Governor Denish will be signing the bills in her capacity as Acting Governor, while Governor Richardson is being honored with a national environmental award in New York City.
