Governor Richardson Invites Public to Participate in Creating the Future of the State Fair

Governor's State Fair Task Force to Meet Tuesday, December 6 in Albuquerque

SANTA FE - Governor Bill Richardson is inviting all interested members of the public to attend and participate in a public meeting of the State Fair Task Force on **Tuesday, December 6 at the TVI Workforce Training Center, 5600 Eagle Rock Ave. NE, Albuquerque.**

The meeting will begin at noon with a public comment session from 6:30 to 8 pm.

“The State Fair is different things to different people -- an annual expo and a tree-shaded Albuquerque oasis as well as a place for trade shows and Tingley concerts,” said Governor Richardson. “This task force will help focus this mission and re-position the fair and fairgrounds for the 21st century.”
