Governor Bill Richardson speaks at conference on ethics, Attend DGA events

SANTA FE - Governor Bill Richardson, chairman of the Democratic Governors Association, will attend several DGA events during the next two days.

Governor Richardson spoke today to the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy in Washington, D.C., about revitalizing public trust in government and business. The NASBA Center for the Public Trust hosted the event, which is designed to address ethics and ethical behavior in business, education, public policy and society.

Governor Richardson is also attending a fundraising event sponsored by the DGA in New York today.

On Friday, Governor Richardson will attend the DGA Fall Policy Conference in Nashville, TN. The conference is focusing on emergency preparedness, homeland security and Medicaid reform and the lessons learned from the handling of Hurricane Katrina.

The Governor will return to New Mexico on Saturday to attend several events, including the New Mexico Music Showcase, a talent show at the State Fair sponsored by the New Mexico Music Commission; the grand opening of the Unser Racing Museum; the Lobo-Aggie football game; and the Presbyterian Healthcare Foundation's annual "Laughter is the Best Medicine" fundraiser to benefit the Presbyterian Nursing Education and Critical Needs.

Governor Richardson's travel is being paid by the DGA.
