Governor Richardson Appoints Four New Members to the Board of Psychological Examiners

Santa Fe - Governor Richardson today announced the appointment of three new professional members to the Board of Psychological Examiners and one public member. Their appointments are effective immediately.

The three professional members include Jane Whitmore, Psy.D., Tomas Granados, Psy.D., and Robert Sherrill, Ph.D. Marilyn Rohn will serve as a public member of the board.

“In addition to their duties to protect the public and advance the psychology profession, the board will continue to bring forward recommendations about how to expand the number of qualified psychologists who choose New Mexico for their home and their practice,” the Governor said. “With their outstanding qualifications and breadth of knowledge about the issues facing their profession in New Mexico, I am confident they will serve all constituents well.”

Dr. Jane Whitmore has a private practice in Santa Fe and will serve as the board chair. Dr. Whitmore was involved with establishing the Santa Fe Municipal Court’s original DWI program.

Dr. Tomas Granados has a private practice in Albuquerque and also serves as Director of Psychology and Neuropsychology at Health South Rehabilitation Hospital. Dr. Granados is bilingual and his practice serves Spanish-speaking clients from the greater Albuquerque and Santa Fe areas.

Dr. Robert Sherrill has a private practice in Farmington and is chair of the NM Psychological Associations Division of Psychopharmacology. Dr. Sherrill is pursuing prescriptive authority training. His practice serves Native Americans from the Navajo community.

The New Mexico Psychological Association recommended Dr. Whitmore and Dr. Granados and the New Mexico State Psychologist Association recommended Dr. Sherrill.

Marilyn Rohn works at Los Alamos National Laboratory in the Health and Safety Division. She has also served on the Governor’s Behavioral Health Planning Council.

The newly appointed members join Dr. Thomas Thompson of Las Cruces, Kandace Blanchard of Albuquerque, Yvonne Yazzie of Albuquerque and Dr. Michael Cobb of Roswell already serving on the Board.
