## **Governor Richardson Announces “In Plain Sight” to Shoot in New Mexico**

*Pilot for NBC Universal Television Studios to shoot in Albuquerque*

**SANTA FE—Governor Bill Richardson announced today that the television pilot, “In Plain Sight” will shoot in New Mexico. Based in Albuquerque, the production will hire approximately 60 New Mexicans.**

**“New Mexico continues to be a location of choice for film and TV productions,” said Governor Bill Richardson. “Series television, such as ‘In Plain Sight,’ is one thing we’re really focusing on because these projects tend to stay here longer and stabilize our production and training base.”**

**Since Richardson took office, the film industry has added more than \$650 million to the state economy.**

**The production’s director is Mark Piznarski (“Veronica Mars”), and executive producers are Paul Stupin (“Dawson’s Creek”) and David Maples. The cast will also include Fred Weller and Leslie Ann Warren.**

**The story opens with Mary Shannon (played by Mary McCormack) as an overworked, underpaid U.S. Marshall who manages individuals relocated to New Mexico as part of a federal witness protection program. While most are career criminals, a few are innocent. All have one thing in common: someone wants them dead. Mary’s job is to make sure that doesn’t happen.**
