Governor Bill Richardson Appoints Clyde DeMersseman to Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court

SANTA FE - Governor Bill Richardson today announced the appointment of Clyde DeMersseman to serve as a judge on the Bernalillo County Metropolitan Court.

“Clyde DeMersseman is a talented attorney and an experienced judge,” said Governor Richardson. “His strong legal experience as well as his calm, deliberate demeanor will make Clyde DeMersseman an excellent Metro Court judge.”

DeMersseman, a registered Republican, served as a Bernalillo Metropolitan Court Judge from August 2005 to December 2006. He is a graduate of the University of Colorado at Boulder and the University Of Denver College Of Law. DeMersseman has practiced personal injury, civil litigation and criminal law in Albuquerque since 1998.

DeMersseman is a former member of the Albuquerque Police Department Task Force on Domestic Violence and the Association of Trial Lawyers of America.

DeMersseman was one of three candidates recommended to Governor Richardson by the Judicial Nominating Commission.

This appointment is effective immediately and lasts until the next general election.
