Governor Richardson Appoints Two to Eastern New Mexico Board of Regents

SANTA FE – Governor Bill Richardson has appointed Randy Harris and re-appointed Robert “Chad” Lydick to the Eastern New Mexico University Board of Regents.

“Randy Harris fought for the people of eastern New Mexico during Cannon’s BRAC proceedings, and I believe he will continue to serve his community well, as a member of the ENMU Board of Regents,” said Governor Richardson.

Randy Harris of Clovis, is President and CEO of the Bank of Clovis. He was a member of the Clovis Committee of 50 and was instrumental during the Base Realignment and Closures process. Randy Harris will replace Alva Carter who died last month and whose term was set to expire at the end of this year. Harris’ term will expire on December 31, 2014.

Chad Lydick also of Clovis; was first appointed by the Governor to the ENMU Board of Regents in February to fill the remainder of former Regent Jay Gurley’s term. Lydick has worked as an engineer and land surveyor for 35 years and is the owner of Lydick Engineers and Surveyors, Inc. He holds a Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering from New Mexico State University. His new term will expire on December 31, 2014.
