House Passes Revised Version of Governor's HealthSOLUTIONS New Mexico Act

Santa Fe, New Mexico – Today the House of Representatives passed a revised version of the Governor's HealthSOLUTIONS New Mexico Act.

Governor Bill Richardson issued the following statement about today's action.

“The important thing is that this bill is moving forward and has passed a major hurdle,” said Governor Bill Richardson. “I urge the Senate to move expeditiously and pass my HealthSOLUTIONS bill; there is no excuse for not acting.”

The revised bill keeps insurance reforms, the Health Care Authority and consolidation of public programs.

House Judiciary Committee Substitute for House Health and Government Affairs Committee for HB 62, as amended twice, now moves to the Senate for consideration. The Governor urges quick action by the Senate to process this piece of legislation before this session ends on Thursday.
