## **Governor Richardson Appoints Nancy Bowles to Public Education Commission**

SANTA FE - Governor Bill Richardson today appointed Nancy Bowles to the Public Education Commission, District 8. Bowles is an educator from Roswell.

“Nancy Bowles will be an excellent addition to the Public Education Commission and I am confident that she will represent the constituents of southern New Mexico well,” said Governor Richardson.

Nancy Bowles has been a teacher with Roswell Independent Schools since 1993 and is currently the Chair of the English Department. Previously, she worked as a nurse at St Mary’s Hospital and as an instructor at Eastern New Mexico University.

Ms. Bowles earned an Associates degree in Science from Olney Central College in Illinois and an Associates degree in Nursing from Eastern New Mexico University. She also holds a bachelors degree in Science in Elementary Education and a Master of Science in Education both from Eastern New Mexico University in Portales. She is currently working on her Ph.D. at the University of New Mexico.

Ms. Bowles was honored with the National Teacher of Influence Award in 2006 and was a finalist for the “Golden Apple Award.”
