## Governor Bill Richardson's Bill Action

SANTA FE - Governor Bill Richardson has signed 37 bills and vetoed 4 bills the 2009 Legislature has sent to him. The Governor has until April 10, 2009 to act on all bills passed by the Legislature and received in the Governor's Office after noon on March 18<sup>th</sup>. There are a number of bills that must be enrolled and engrossed before they can be sent to the Governor; the pending bill action below only includes bills received.
