## **Governor Bill Richardson Names Doug Brown to Head Search for New State Investment Officer**

*Governor Names Bob Jacksha as Interim CIO*

SANTA FE – Governor Bill Richardson announced today that he is appointing Doug Brown to head the search for a new State Investment Officer. Brown was tapped by Governor Richardson in 2005 to fill in as State Treasurer, and is currently Dean of the University of New Mexico’s Anderson School of Management.

“Doug Brown has a history of unselfish service to the state and I appreciate the fact that he is willing to head the search for one of the most important positions in state government,” said Governor Richardson, who is the chairman of the State Investment Council.

Brown will lead a search committee that includes four current members of the State Investment Council: Katherine Miller, Secretary of the state Department of Finance & Administration; Andrew Davis, a portfolio manager with Davis Advisors; Stephen L. Feinberg, Chairman and CEO of Dorsar Investment Company and corporate director for continental Transmission Corporation; and Peter B. Frank, who retired as Executive Vice President and chief Financial Officer from Daymon Worldwide Inc.

Governor Richardson also named Bob Jacksha, who currently serves as Chief Investment Officer for the Education Retirement Board, to serve as interim State Investment Officer during the search. Jacksha previously served as Deputy State Investment Officer for the State Investment Council.
