FLAGS FLOWN AT HALF-STAFF IN HONOR AND MEMORY OF ROSWELL FIREFIGHTER JEFF STROBLE

WHEREAS, Jeff Stroble, a seventeen-year veteran of the Roswell Fire Department, died in the line of duty on July 21, 2019, after having bravely served his state and community over the course of an honorable career in public safety;

WHEREAS, Jeff Stroble was a native New Mexican who graduated from Goddard High School in Roswell and he is survived by his parents, Charles and Annie Stroble; wife, Reba Stroble; children, Kyle, Tyler, and Kadie; and two grandchildren;

WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico was honored by Jeff Stroble's commendable work and service, as well as his commitment to his community; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and proper to publicly acknowledge and honor Jeff Stoble's heroism and life through a public day of mourning across New Mexico.

THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by the virtue of authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT that all state flags be flown at half-staff from sundown of July 25, 2019 through sundown of July 26, 2019. This action will serve to honor Jeff Stroble and to mourn his loss.
