Dear President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of a Bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .215755. That Bill eliminates the State Fire Marshal Division from the Public Regulation Commission; creates the State Fire Marshal's Office as a division within the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Department; and accordingly transfers personnel, functions, money, appropriations, and other property and contractual obligations between the divisions. The Bill also contains new provisions pertaining to the appointment, powers, and duties of the State Fire Marshal and the creation of the Fire Services Council.
