Dear President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of Senate Bill 179, which enacts a new section of the State Rules Act to provide a limited exception from public comment period and hearing requirements for the adoption by reference of a rule mandated by a federal agency in order for the State to maintain authorization to implement a federal program or to receive federal funding; and amends rulemaking provisions of the Environmental Improvement Act and Hazardous Waste Act to provide for the same limited exception.
