Dear President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of Senate Bill 130, which provides that a student who has experienced a disruption in the student's education and has transferred between public schools shall receive credit for any work completed prior to the transfer. The Bill also requires school districts, with guidance from the Public Education Department, to create policies to determine how to award credit for partially completed courses.
