## SENATE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 64

The Honorable Mary Kay Papen, President Pro Tempore and Members of the New Mexico State Senate State Capitol Building Santa Fe, NM 87501

Dear President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of Senate Bill 270, which amends the Electronic Communications Privacy Act to alter the requirements and procedures for obtaining a warrant for the search and seizure of electronic information; to provide that information obtained through a warrant or order must be destroyed or sealed under certain circumstances; to clarify that information voluntarily disclosed by a service provider or obtained by a government entity because of an emergency may only be subject to further review or disclosure under certain circumstances; and to amend requirements for reporting certain actions to the Attorney General.
