ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF IN MEMORIAL OF THE HONORABLE LIONEL WILLIAMS

The Honorable Lionel Williams served the State and his community as a bailiff at the Eleventh Judicial District Court. He tragically passed away on November 28, 2020.

Lionel Williams will be remembered for his friendship and his warmth. He leaves behind an enduring legacy in McKinley and San Juan Counties.

It is appropriate and proper to acknowledge Lionel Williams' life and service through a public period of mourning.

THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT that all state flags in McKinley County and San Juan County be flown at half-staff beginning December 1, 2020 and lasting though sundown of December 3, 2020. This action will serve to commemorate Lionel Williams' distinguished life and to mourn his loss.
