Dear Speaker Egolf and Members of the House:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fifth Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .222055, a bill aligning New Mexico commercial driver's license requirements with federal law by amending and repealing sections of the New Mexico Commercial Driver's License Act; amending the Motor Vehicle Code to include definitions for "non-domiciled," "non-resident nonresident commercial driver's instruction permit," "non-domiciled commercial driver's instruction permit," and "non-domiciled commercial driver's license;" enacting a new section of the New Mexico Commercial Driver's License Act regarding non-domiciled commercial driver's licenses or non-domiciled commercial driver's instruction permits.
