

Dear President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fifth Legislature, Second Session, submission of SENATE BILL 100, a bill clarifying the definition of "cannabis"; specifying the process of criminal history records checks for certain persons; providing for certain minimum requirements for licensees and their employees; prohibiting the sale of cannabis and alcohol on the same premises; providing for joint powers agreements relating to inspections; clarifying business location reporting for tax purposes; and authorizing certain nonprofit medical cannabis producers to dissolve their nonprofit corporation and transfer assets under certain circumstances.
