Dear President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fifth Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .222293, a bill establishing when a rebuttable presumption arises that a person is dangerous to any other person or to the community and no release conditions will reasonably protect the safety of any other person or the community; confirming the prosecuting authority's burden of proof in pretrial detention hearings; and declaring an emergency.
