## SENATE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 39

Dear President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fifth Legislature, Second Session, submission of SENATE BILL 198, a bill transferring responsibility for various transportation regulation from the Public Regulation Commission to the Department of Transportation; transferring personnel, functions, money, appropriations, other property, and contractual obligations related to such transportation regulation; changing related references in law; eliminating from the Motor Carrier Act redundant permits for transportation of passengers or household goods pursuant to a contract; removing outdated references in the Aviation Act and the Rural Air Service Enhancement Act; repealing provisions relating to aviation common carriers and air traffic rules; and amending, repealing and enacting various related sections of the NMSA 1978.
