EXECUTIVE ORDER 2022-058

REDUCING ADMINISTRATIVE BURDENS IN THE NEW MEXICO PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Public Education Department ("PED") has the authority and responsibility to ensure that its teachers and administrators spend as much time as possible focusing on educating students.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of New Mexico do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. PED shall conduct outreach to teachers and school administrators to determine best practices to streamline reporting and other administrative burdens.
- 2. By the start of the 2022-23 academic year, PED shall identify and implement changes to reduce administrative burdens for teachers and school administrators by at least 25%.

I FURTHER ORDER and DIRECT as follows:

- This Order supersedes any previous orders, proclamations, policies, or directives to the extent they are in conflict.
- 2. This Order shall take effect immediately, and shall remain in effect until renewed, modified, or rescinded.
