EXECUTIVE ORDER 2022-105

AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR NEW MEXICO NATIONAL GUARD DEPLOYMENTS IN FISCAL YEAR 2023

WHEREAS, when resources of the New Mexico National Guard are needed in support of civil emergencies and disasters, including search and rescue missions, this support must be immediately deployable; and

WHEREAS, funding for National Guard assets must be in place prior to any mission assignment to assure a rapid and unhindered deployment in time of need.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby **ORDER**, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 20-1-4(A), (D), -6, NMSA 1978, Section 20-2-3(A), and NMSA 1978, Section 20-4-3(A), into service any elements of the New Mexico National Guard that are, or may be necessary to provide support to civilian authorities in any county of the State of New Mexico in response to civil emergencies, disasters, or search and rescue missions. I further **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. The sum of seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) is authorized for payment of expenses incident to the provision of services authorized by this Order. This authorized amount shall be available July 1, 2022, for missions through June 30, 2023.
2. Missions other than search and rescue shall be contingent upon approval by the Governor, or the Governor's Authorized Representative or designated alternate.

3. This Order supersedes any other previous orders, proclamations, or directives in conflict.

4. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until renewed, modified, or rescinded.
