President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Sixth Legislature, Second Session, submission of SENATE BILL 145, a bill prohibiting public bodies from entering into agreements to detain individuals for federal civil immigration violations and requiring the termination of any such existing agreements; and prohibiting public bodies from otherwise using public resources to facilitate detaining individuals for federal civil immigration violations.


