President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Sixth Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .226574, a bill amending certain definitions in the Legislative Lottery Tuition Scholarship Act; changing certain requirements for eligibility for the Legislative Lottery Tuition Scholarship; providing an exception to the minimum credit-hour eligibility requirement in the Opportunity Scholarship Act; exempting dual credit classes from counting toward the Opportunity Scholarship credit-hour cap; and allowing credit for summer semesters in each scholarship.
