## SENATE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 7

President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Sixth Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .227260, a bill establishing when a rebuttable presumption arises that a defendant is likely to pose a threat to the safety of others if released pending trial and that no release conditions will reasonably protect the safety of any other person or the community; and confirming the prosecution's burden of proof in pretrial detention hearings.


