ORDER LOWERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF IN MEMORIAL OF OFFICER TIMOTHY ONTIVEROS

Officer Timothy Ontiveros of the Bloomfield Police Department tragically lost his life after being shot and killed in the line of duty while conducting a traffic stop on May 26, 2025. Officer Ontiveros exemplified extraordinary bravery and unwavering dedication in serving and protecting his fellow New Mexicans. He will be greatly missed by his family and community and will be remembered as a dedicated father to his two daughters, a fighter and a true public servant. It is appropriate and proper to acknowledge Officer Ontiveros' life and service through a public period of mourning across New Mexico.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT** that all United States and State flags be flown at half-staff beginning June 5, 2025, and lasting through sundown of June 10, 2025. This action will serve to commemorate Officer Ontiveros' life and to mourn his loss.
