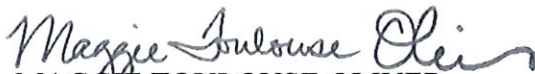
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2025-414

ORDER LOWERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF IN MEMORIAL OF SENATOR CLINT HARDEN

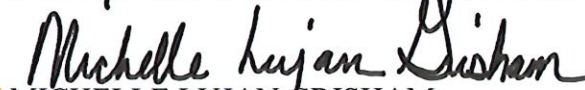
