Speaker Martinez and Members of the House:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, submission of HOUSE BILL 30, a bill amending the Teacher Residency Act; providing that the amount of the stipend for a teaching resident be set at a percentage of the statutory minimum salary for level one teachers based on the resident's qualifications; providing that a teaching resident may work at any public school after the residency instead of a public school in the sponsoring school district; and providing that a partner school district or charter school shall be expected to offer employment to a teaching resident depending on the district's or charter school's staffing needs and the resident's performance.
