President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .232698, a bill transferring from the Department of Transportation to the Department of Health responsibility for administering and enforcing the Ambulance Standards Act, including establishing standards, requirements, tariffs, terms of service and service territories, promulgating rules, accepting applications, and issuing certificates for ambulance services; creating the ambulance certification program; providing for objections, protests, and public hearings; providing to the Department of Health access to certified ambulance service records and the powers of enforcement and subpoena; transferring personnel, functions, money, appropriations, other property, and contractual obligations; recompiling the Ambulance Standards Act and changing references in law; and making an appropriation.
