President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, submission of SENATE BILL 53, a bill strengthening privacy protections by enacting the Community and Health Information Safety and Privacy Act; providing definitions; providing duties for covered entities; establishing requirements for service providers; prohibiting certain uses of consumer data; providing rights to consumers; establishing limitations on processing of consumer data; prohibiting waivers of rights and retaliatory denials of service; and providing for enforcement and penalties.
