
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2026-008

ORDER LOWERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF IN MEMORIAL OF SERGEANT MICHAEL SCHLATTMAN

Sergeant Michael Schlattman of the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office tragically lost his life while conducting a traffic stop on February 23, 2026. Sergeant Schlattman exemplified true leadership and dedication in serving and protecting his fellow New Mexicans. He will be greatly missed by his family and community and will be remembered as a dedicated leader and a true public servant. It is appropriate and proper to acknowledge Officer Schlattman's life and service through a public period of mourning across New Mexico.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Michelle Lujan Grisham, Governor of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of New Mexico, do hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT** that all United States and State flags be flown at half-staff beginning March 2, 2026, and lasting through sundown of March 5, 2026. This action will serve to commemorate Sergeant Schlattman's life and to mourn his loss.
