### HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 70

Speaker Martinez and Members of the House:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, submission of HOUSE BILL 219, a bill requiring greater cooperation between schools and juvenile probation services in the enforcement of the Attendance For Success Act; requiring a preliminary inquiry of a delinquency complaint to include a review of the child's school attendance; requiring juvenile probation services to initiate or review interventions for a child subject to a delinquency complaint who is chronically or excessively absent from school; requiring a children's court attorney to initiate proceedings pursuant to the Family in Need of Court-Ordered Services Act for certain children who are chronically or excessively absent from school; authorizing juvenile probation services to initiate enforcement of the Attendance For Success Act for certain students who are chronically or excessively absent from school; providing juvenile probation services with immediate access to a student's attendance records; and making conforming amendments.
