President Pro Tempore Stewart and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Seventh Legislature, Second Session, submission of a bill bearing Legislative Council Service drafting number .233620, a bill amending the requirements of and exceptions to the mandatory policy implemented by a school district or charter school regarding student use of wireless communication devices; requiring the prohibition of student use of wireless communication devices during the school day; amending the Education Technology Infrastructure Fund to allow grants to a school district or charter school that implements a policy prohibiting student use of wireless communication devices during the school day; and including a school district's implementation of the policy prohibiting student use of wireless communication devices as part of the criteria for Education Technology Infrastructure grants.
